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CHAPTER CCCXLVIII.

AN ACT to alter the times of holding the Courts of Sessions in the County of Cumberland.

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That from and after the passing of this Act, the terms of the Court of Sessions in and for the county of Cumberland, shall be holden at Portland, in and for the county of Cumberland, on the first Tuesday of June and the third Tuesday in December, annually, instead of the times heretofore designated by law. And all matters and things now pending in, or returnable to said Court, as heretofore holden, shall be returned to, have day in, and be heard at the term of said Court, which shall be holden on said first Tuesday in June next.
