Chapter 49.

Resolve in favor of Nathaniel Fernald.

Approved February 28, 1832.

Resolved, That the Land Agent be, and hereby is authorized to convey to Nathaniel Fernald, by deed in fee simple, an Island called Ten Pound Island, in the County of Hancock, which is now in the possession of the State.

Chapter 50.

Resolve in favor of Asaph R. Nichols.

Approved February 28, 1832.

Resolved, That the Justices of the Court of Common Pleas, be, and they are hereby authorized to admit Asaph R. Nichols to practise law as an Attorney of said Court, he paying the duty required by law; *Provided*, that on examination either by said Court, or some person or persons by them appointed, he shall be found suitably qualified.

Chapter 51.

Resolve in favor of Charles Jarvis.

Approved February 29, 1832.

Resolved, That the Land Agent be, and hereby is authorized to convey to Charles Jarvis, by deed in fee simple, a lot of land in the town of Ellsworth, numbered two hundred and sixty two, for which he has paid the consideration.
