Chapter 85.

Resolve to distribute Greenleaf's Maps and Statistical View of Maine.

Approved March 8, 1832.

Resolved, That there be furnished to each incorporated Academy in this State, (not previously furnished by Resolve of March tenth, eighteen hundred and thirty,) for the use of the same, one copy of Greenleaf's Map and Statistical View of Maine. And the Treasurer of the State be and he is hereby authorized to procure the same in the same manner, stated and directed in said Resolve of March tenth, eighteen hundred and thirty.

Chapter 86.

Resolve relating to the Aroostook Road.

Approved March 8, 1832.

Resolved, That the authority given to the Land Agent of this State in conjunction with the Land Agent of Massachusetts by a Resolve of March 30, one thousand eight hundred and thirty one be so enlarged that they may be authorized to locate and survey the Aroostook road, so that it may strike the Aroostook river, at any place between the West line of the third range, and the East line of the sixth range of townships West of the East line of the State.

Chapter 87.

Resolve in favor of Asahel Brainard.

Approved March 8, 1832.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid out of the Treasury of this State to Asahel Brainard the sum of twenty four dollars and eighteen cents; said sum being in full for his services in labor as a carpenter on the public Buildings of the State at Augusta in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty.
