Chapter 162.

AN ACT repealing part of 'An Act providing for the promotion of Education.'

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That the third section of 'An Act providing for the promotion of Education,' passed the twenty third day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight be and hereby is repealed.

Chapter 163.

AN ACT to repeal an Act additional to an Act establishing the Court of Common Pleas.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That an Act entitled an Act additional to an Act establishing the Court of Common Pleas, approved the 29th day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty-one, be and the same hereby is repealed.

Chapter 164.

AN ACT additional concerning Banks and Banking.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That the third section of an Act passed the fourth day of March one thousand eight hundred and thirty-three, entitled 'An Act additional to an Act to regulate Banks and Banking,' be and the same hereby is repealed.
