Chapter 162.

AN ACT repealing part of 'An Act providing for the promotion of Education.'

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That the Former Act repealed. third section of 'An Act providing for the promotion of Education,' passed the twenty third day of Feb- Vol. 3, ch. 103, p. 254. ruary in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight be and hereby is repealed.

Chapter 163.

AN ACT to repeal an Act additional to an Act establishing the Court of Common Pleas.
