RESOLVES

OF THE

FIFTEENTH LEGISLATURE,

OF THE

STATE OF MAINE,

PASSED AT THE SESSION

Which commenced on the seventh day of January, and ended on the twenty-fourth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-five.

Published agreeably to the Resolve of June 28, 1820.

RESOLVED, That every officer, soldier and widow aforesaid, who shall become the owner of land under the provisions of these Resolves, shall hold the same exempt from attachment on mesne process or execution.

Chapter 40.

Resolve for the preservation and repair of the Canada Road.

Approved March 17, 1835.

RESOLVED, That a sum not exceeding Four Hundred Dollars, be and hereby is appropriated for the preservation and repair of the Canada Road north of the Bingham Purchase, to be expended under the direction of the Governor and Council.

Chapter 41.

Resolve for the preservation and repair of the Mars Hill Road.

Approved March 17, 1835.

RESOLVED, That a sum not exceeding Eight Hundred Dollars, be and hereby is appropriated for repairs of the Mars Hill Road, from its commencement in the town of Lincoln, in the County of Penobscot, to its termination in Houlton, in the County of Washington ; to be expended under the direction of the Governor and Council.
