## Chapter 48.

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# Resolve in favor of Union Academy at Kennebank.

## Approved March 19, 1835.

**RESOLVED**, That the Secretary of State be, and he hereby is authorized and directed to deliver to the Trustees of Union Academy located at Kennebunk, one copy of Greenleaf's Statistical view of Maine, with the maps which accompany the same, for the use of that Institution.

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## Chapter 49.

#### Resolve in favor of Israel Chadbourn.

Approved March 19, 1835.

**RESOLVED**, That there be paid out of the Treasury to Israel Chadbourn of Alfred in the County of York the sum of Twelve Dollars for his attendance as a witness before a Committee of the Legislature and bringing original papers in the case of the new gaol in the County of York the same to be paid out of the Treasury from any money not otherwise appropriated.
