RESOLVED, That the Governor be authorized to call for the books of said Company, and by and with the advice of Council to appoint one or more auditors to investigate the same.

Chapter 71.

Resolve authorizing the Treasurer to pay a portion of the public debt.

Approved March 24, 1835.

RESOLVED, That the Treasurer of the State be and hereby is authorized and directed, whenever in his opinion the state of the finances will admit of it, to pay to Reuel Williams, Esq. the amount due to him from the State under the Resolve of the fourth of March one thousand eight hundred and thirty three.

Chapter 72.

Resolve in favor of the Judge and Register of Probate in the Northern District in the County of Washington.

Approved March 24, 1835.

RESOLVED, That the Treasurer of State be and hereby is authorized to remit to the Judge and Register of Probate appointed to the Northern District in the County of Washington—the excise duty required by law on their respective commissions.
