Chapter 32.

AN ACT concerning Hallowell Academy.

Approved February 23, 1836.

repeated.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Part of former act Legislature assembled, That so much of the seventh section of an Act of the General Court of Massachusetts, passed March 5, 1791, entitled an Act to establish an Academy in the town of Hallowell, by the name of the Hallowell Academy, as requires "that a major part of the Trustees shall consist of men who are not inhabitants of the Town where the Seminary is or may be situate," be and the same is hereby repealed.

Chapter 33.

AN ACT to annex a tract of Land to Waldo Plantation.

Approved February 23, 1836.

Persons set off from Belmont and annexed to Waldo Plantation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That Daniel Hilt, John Jones, and Jesse Wentworth, with their Farms bounded westerly by Belmont, northerly by Knox, easterly by Brooks, and southerly by the Waldo Plantation, be, and the same are annexed to the said Waldo Plantation.
