RESOLVED, That there be paid out of the Treasury of the State to William Shed of Albany in the County of Oxford the sum of Sixty Dollars in full compensation for an injury sustained by him while on military duty.

Chapter 15.

Resolve in favor of Oliver Perkins.

Approved February 21, 1837.

RESOLVED, That there be paid out of the Treasury of the State, to Oliver Perkins of Kennebunk, the sum of Fifty Dollars, also, a pension of Eight Dollars per month, until otherwise ordered by the Legislature; commencing on the first day of January eighteen hundred and thirtyseven, in consideration of a severe injury sustained by him while performing military duty.

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Resolve authorizing the County Commissioners for Hancock

Approved February 21, 1837.

RESOLVED, That the County Commissioners for Hancock County be and they hereby are authorized to borrow in behalf of said County a sum of money not less than Four Thousand Dollars, nor more than Eight Thousand Dollars, at a rate of interest not exceeding six per cent. per annum, for the purpose of erecting and fitting up suitable buildings at Ellsworth for the Courts, a Jail and the County Offices, The interest on said sum to be paid by said County annually, and the principal, or sum so borrowed
