Chapter 30.

Resolve in favor of Nicholas Pierce.

Approved February 16, 1839.

RESOLVED, That there be paid out of the Treasury of State to Nicholas Pierce of Limerick, the sum of Four Dollars and fifty cents per month, during the term of five years, commencing on the tenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty nine, the same being a pension for an injury sustained by him while on military duty.

Chapter 31.

Resolve in favor of George Williston.

Approved February 16, 1839.

RESOLVED, That there be paid out of the Treasury of the State to George Williston of Brunswick, the sum of One Hundred and Eighty Eight Dollars in full remuneration for an injury sustained by him while doing military duty.

Chapter 32.

Resolve in favor of William M. Jordan.

Approved February 16, 1839.

RESOLVED, That there be paid out of the Treasury of the State to William M. Jordan of Poland, Four Dollars per month, for one year, in consequence of an injury sustained by him while on military duty.
