**Chapter 131.**

RESOLVE in favor of J. Merrill and others.

*Resolved*, That there be paid out of the treasury of this State, to J. Merrill eight dollars and sixty-six cents, Upton Treat six dollars and seventy-four cents, Robert Sargent five dollars and twenty-three cents, and P. R. Hazeltine three dollars and eighty-three cents, for balance due them as president, members and marshal, of a division court martial, duly ordered and holden at Belfast, in the third division, December, eighteen hundred and thirty-seven.

**Chapter 132.**

RESOLVE in favor of the town of Knox.

*Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the treasury of the State, to the town of Knox, the sum of twenty-one dollars and seventy-eight cents, it being the balance of the bank tax due said town, for the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty-nine.

**Chapter 133.**

RESOLVE in favor of the town of Limington.

*Resolved*, That there be paid out of the treasury of the State, to the town of Limington, ten dollars, for an error in a wheat bounty in eighteen hundred and thirty-nine.
