Chapter 190.

RESOLVE on the Pay Roll of the Clerks of the Committee on the State Valuation.

Resolved, That there be paid to the several persons named in the preceding Roll, the sum set against their names respectively, amounting in the whole, to the sum of one thousand five hundred and eighty-six dollars, and to Isaac Tyler, for two nights' work, three dollars.

Chapter 191.

AN ADDITIONAL RESOLVE relating to the Revised Statutes.

Resolved, That the commissioners, appointed by the Resolves passed October twenty-second, in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty, entitled "Resolves relating to the Revised Statutes," be allowed such reasonable compensation for their services and expenses, as the Governor and Council may determine; and the Governor is hereby authorized to draw his warrants on the Treasurer, for the amounts so allowed, to be paid from any money not otherwise appropriated.

[Approved April 16, 1841.]

Chapter 192.

RESOLVE for defraying expenses of certain committees.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid to Nathaniel Hutchins, the sum of six dollars, for the use of room, fire, lights &c. for the joint special committee on gubernatorial votes; and there be allowed and paid to Samuel L. Harris, the sum of fifteen dollars, and to Elijah Robinson, the sum of three dollars, for services by the direction of the joint special committee upon the north-eastern boundary; and that the Governor with the advice of the Council, is authorized to draw his warrants on the Treasurer for the same.
