Chapter 1.

An act to repeal an act to prevent imposition in the sale of medicine.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. That an act entitled "an act to prevent imposition in the sale of medicine," approved August eighth, one thousand eight hundred and forty-six, is hereby repealed. Act of August 8, 1846, repealed.

SECT. 2. This act shall not affect any prosecutions commenced prior to its passage. Prosecutions previously commenced, not affected.

Chapter 2.

An act to repeal the third section of an act entitled "an act in relation to the duties, privileges and liabilities of mutual fire insurance companies," approved August seventh, one thousand eight hundred and forty-six.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

The third section of an act entitled "an act in relation to the duties, privileges and liabilities of mutual fire insurance companies," approved August seventh, one thousand eight hundred and forty-six, is hereby repealed. Sec. 3 of act of Aug. 7, 1846, repealed.
