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**Chapter 217.****CHAP. 217.**

Resolve authorizing the acting quartermaster general to dispose of certain articles of state property.

*Resolved*, That the acting quartermaster general is hereby authorized to sell at public or private sale, under the direction of the governor, the following articles of property belonging to the state, viz: the artillery gun house and site upon which it stands in the town of Hallowell; the old arsenal building in the city of Bath, with the articles contained in it rendered useless by injury or decay, the net proceeds not exceeding two hundred and fifty dollars to be applied under the direction of said quartermaster general for the purpose of erecting a gun house in the town of Gardiner, and the balance to be deposited in the treasury of the state for the use thereof.

Authorized to sell artillery gun house and site at Hallowell.

Proceeds, how applied.

**Chapter 218.**

Resolve in favor of James B. Norris.

*Resolved*, That there be paid from the treasury of state out of any money not otherwise appropriated, to James B. Norris, eleven dollars for services rendered the state in eighteen hundred and forty-eight, in summoning the president and directors of Ticonic Bank to appear before the committee on banks and banking, on petition of Levi Johnson, agreeably to a vote of the legislature of eighteen hundred and forty-eight.

**Chapter 219.**

Resolve providing for the reception of a sword presented by the honorable Paulinus M. Foster.

*Resolved*, That the sword presented by the honorable Paulinus M. Foster in behalf of Major T. H. Crosby of the ninth regiment, to the governor, and by him to the State of Maine, recently taken from the enemy in the war with Mexico, be received and placed with the archives of the state.
