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**Chapter 178.****CHAP. 178.**

An act repealing “an act relating to mutual fire and marine insurance companies.”

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

An act approved August thirteenth in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and and forty-nine, and entitled “an act relating to mutual fire and marine insurance companies,” is hereby repealed.

**Chapter 179.**

An act to increase the salary of the county attorney for the county of Hancock.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECT. 1. The county attorney for the county of Hancock shall be entitled to receive a salary in quarterly payments on the first day of January, April, July and October of each year, of two hundred dollars per annum, instead of the sum now allowed.

Salary, \$200.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the governor.

**Chapter 180.**

An act to amend the one hundred and twenty-fifth chapter of the revised statutes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

The thirty-second section of the one hundred and twenty-fifth chapter of the revised statutes, is hereby amended by adding at the end of said section the following words: “and if such mortgager shall reside in any unincorporated place, the mortgage shall be recorded in that incorporated town which may be nearest to the place where said mortgager resides.

Property mortgaged in unincorporated places, where recorded.
