CHAP. 260.**Chapter 260.**

Resolve in relation to a check list in the town of Kennebec.

Selectmen allowed to make check list of votes.

Resolved, That the town of Kennebec, in the county of Kennebec, by their selectmen, yet to be chosen, be allowed to make a check list of the voters in said town, on Saturday, the seventh day of September next, and that said list shall be used and subserve all purposes as if made as the law now provides in the several towns in this state.

Chapter 261.

Resolve in favor of Fryeburg Academy.

In favor of Fryeburg Academy.

Resolved, That the land agent be authorized and directed to convey to the trustees of Fryeburg Academy one half township of land, from any of the lands held in severalty by the state.

[*Approved August 17, 1850.*]

Chapter 262.

Resolve in favor of Farmington Academy.

In favor of trustees of Farmington Academy.

Resolved, That the land agent of this state is hereby authorized and directed to convey to the trustees of Farmington Academy one half township of land to be selected by the land agent from any land now owned in severalty by this state.

Chapter 263.

Resolve in favor of Anson Academy.

In favor of Anson Academy.

Resolved, That the land agent be authorized and directed to convey to the trustees of Anson Academy, one half township of land from any of the lands held in severalty by this state.

[*Approved August 17, 1850.*]
