Chapter 264.**CHAP. 264.**

Resolve in favor of Cherryfield Academy.

Resolved, That the land agent is hereby authorized to convey to the trustees of the Cherryfield Academy, one half township of land to be selected from the lands belonging to this state in severalty, provided it shall be made to appear to the land agent on or before the first Monday in June, eighteen hundred and fifty-one, that the trustees of said academy have provided a good and substantial academical building and commenced a school therein, and have acquired corporate property to the amount of one thousand dollars.

Chapter 265.

Resolve respecting the Artillery gun house in Calais.

Resolved, That the Frontier Rifle Corps at Calais be permitted to occupy the upper story of the Artillery gun house situated in the town of Calais, for the purpose of an armory, and that there be and is hereby granted and allowed the sum of not exceeding one hundred and fifty dollars for the repair and fitting up of said building, to be expended under the direction of the acting quartermaster general.

Frontier Rifle Corps authorized to occupy artillery gun house for an armory.

Chapter 266.

Resolve for the payment of bounties to the Passamaquoddy Indians upon agricultural productions.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid from the Indian fund of the Passamaquoddy tribe of Indians to Sylvanus Leland late agent for Passamaquoddy tribe of Indians, the sum of two hundred and eighty-five dollars and twenty-one cents being the amount paid by the said agent to the Indians aforesaid for bounties upon agricultural productions for the year eighteen hundred and forty-nine.
