Chapter 281.

Resolve empowering the treasurer of state to receive certain moneys of the United States.

Resolved, That the treasurer of state be and hereby is authorized to receive any sums of money which may be allowed to the state of Maine by the government of the United States for interest on advances made by said state, the principal whereof has been heretofore allowed, and to execute proper receipts and acquittances therefor.
