EXTRA SESSION, 1853.

Chapter 186.

An act in amendment of an act entitled "An act to extend the time of filing the location, and the time for completing the railroad of the Great. Falls and South Berwick Branch Railroad Company."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The time for filing the location of said railroad Time for filing location. with the county commissioners of the county of York, is hereby extended to the first day of January, eighteen hundred and fifty-five; and said company is hereby authorized to file a new location thereof; and the time for completing said railroad is Time for comextended to the first day of January, eighteen hundred and fifty-six.

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the Inconsistent acts provisions of said first section, are hereby repealed.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from the time of its passage.
