Chapter 117.

Resolve in favor of James Robinson.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid out of the treasury of the state to James Robinson eight dollars per month during the pleasure of the legislature, in consequence of loss of health while in the service of the state in the winter of eighteen hundred and thirty-nine.

Chapter 118.

Resolve in favor of Hartly Hamilton.

Resolved, That the land agent be authorized to convey to Hartly Hamilton lot numbered fifty-seven in Indian township numbered one, the said Hamilton having paid an adequate compensation therefor to the state.

Resolve in aid of roads in the county of Penobscot.

Resolved, That the land agent be authorized to expend the sum of three hundred dollars in repairing road leading across township number three, range five, and the further sum of two hundred dollars for repairing road leading across township number five, sixth range, in the county of Penobscot.
