Chapter 196.

Resolve on the pay roll of the senate.

Resolved, That there be paid to the several persons in the accompanying roll, the sums set against their names respectively, amounting in the whole to the sum of seven thousand five hundred and eighty-one dollars and fifty cents.

Resolve in favor of Samuel Wasson.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the treasury to Samuel Wasson, the sum of eight dollars and eighty-seven cents, being expenses by him incurred by reason of sickness while in attendance as a member of the senate at the present session of the legislature.
