Chapter 328.

Resolve in favor of Josiah D. Pulsifer.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the treasury from money not otherwise appropriated, to Josiah D. Pulsifer the sum of twenty-five dollars, being the sum paid into the said treasury by the said Pulsifer through mistake and under a misapprehension of the requirements of law.

Chapter 329.

Resolve granting one hundred and sixty acres of land to aid in building a bridge across Salmon brook in township number thirteen, range three.

Resolved, That the land agent be and is hereby authorized to convey to Isaac Wilder a lot of land of one hundred and sixty acres, to be selected by him in township number thirteen, range three, west from the east line of the state, when said Wilder shall have built a good and substantial bridge across Salmon brook, a tributary of the Aroostook river in said township; said bridge to be built to the acceptance of said land agent.

Bridge across Salmon brook, in favor of.

Chapter 330.

Resolve in aid of bridges in township number four, range four, west from the east line of the state.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated to be expended under the direction of the land agent in aid of building and completing bridges over Cold brook, Sly brook and the Mattawamkeag in said township, which sum is to be paid when the inhabitants shall have completed said bridges to the acceptance of the land agent.
