CHAP. 343.

Chapter 343.

Resolve in favor of the town of Vassalborough.

Vassalborough,

Resolved, That the treasurer of state be authorized to pay to the treasurer of the town of Vassalborough, out of the unappropriated school fund of eighteen hundred and sixty, the sum of one hundred and forty-three dollars and nineteen cents, said sum being the amount due said Vassalborough, occasioned by an error in the returns of the secretary of state to the treasurer of state of the number of scholars anno domini eighteen hundred and fifty-nine.

Chapter 344.

Resolve in favor of the committee on the defalcation of Benjamin D. Peck.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the treasury of the state, the sum of fifty-two dollars and fifty cents, to be paid for expenses incurred by special committees sent to Bangor and Portland by order of the committee of investigation on the affairs of the treasury, said sum being the amount actually paid for traveling and other necessary expenses in the discharge of their duty and in full of all demands.

Chapter 345.

Resolve designating and locating certain townships for settlement.

Certain town-
ships design-

settlement.

Resolved, That the following townships be, and the same are hereby designated and located for settlement, viz: townships numbered two, range three; fifteen, range three; fourteen, range four; and the state's interest in the following townships, viz: eighteen, range three; sixteen, range seven; seventeen, range seven; eighteen, range seven; all lying west from the east line of the state, in the county of Aroostook. Also, township numbered four, range nine, north of Waldo Patent, in the county of Piscataquis.
