CHAP. 99.**Chapter 99.**

Resolve in favor of the widow of the late Tristram Redman.

Tristram Redman, widow of, in favor of.

Resolved, That there be paid out of any money in the treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of thirty-six dollars, being the amount to which the late Tristram Redman would have been entitled as a member of the senate at this session had he survived, to be paid to his widow, and that the governor draw his warrant for the same.

Chapter 100.

Resolve in favor of the widow of Isaac T. Cole.

Isaac T. Cole, widow of, in favor of.

Resolved, That the governor be authorized to draw his warrant on the treasurer for any money not otherwise appropriated, in favor of the widow of Isaac T. Cole, late a member of this house, for the amount that would have been due him for travel and attendance at the present session had he survived, being the sum of forty-two dollars.
