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### Chapter 281.

Resolve in favor of Penobscot Indians.

*Resolved,* That there be paid out of the treasury, the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to pay a man to superintend the farming interests of Penobscot Indians.

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### Chapter 282.

Resolve to sustain the national government.

*Resolved,* That in the present crisis of our country there is no choice but to sustain the constituted authorities or to submit to armed traitors.

*Resolved,* That in order to put down the rebellion, the people will sustain the government of the United States with all the resources at their command.
