Chapter 219.

An act to further continue in force the provisions of chapter seventy-one of the laws of eighteen hundred sixty-two, concerning the suspension of specie payments.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legis-Lature assembled, as follows:

Chapter seventy-one of the laws of eighteen hundred sixty-two, entitled "an act to suspend certain provisions in chapter fortyseven of the revised statutes concerning banks," is hereby further continued in force until the fifteenth day of January, eighteen hundred sixty-five; and this act shall be in force on and after its approval by the governor.

Chap. 71, laws of 1862, contin-ued in force.

Chapter 220.

An act to prevent enlistments in this state upon the quota of any other state.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislatue assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Whoever shall enlist any person residing in this state and being an inhabitant thereof, in the quota of any town or city of any other state, for the military service of said other state or of the United States, or shall aid and assist in the voluntary or involuntary removal of any inhabitant of this state for the purpose of enlisting him in the military service of the United States upon the quota of any other state, shall be liable to fine of five hundred Penalty.
