CHAP. 21.

Chapter 21.

An act to amend chapter two hundred fifty-six of the public laws of the year eighteen hundred sixty-four.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Amendments.

SECT. 1. The second section of chapter two hundred fifty-six of the public laws of eighteen hundred sixty four, is hereby amended by striking out the word "eleven" in the third line as printed, and inserting in place thereof the word *thirteen*; and by striking out the word "two" in the eighth line of said section and inserting in place thereof the word *five*.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force when approved by the governor.

Chapter 22.

An act in relation to repairs of roads in unincorporated townships.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Assessments
for repairs to
be made by co.
commissioners.

The expenses for repairing roads in unincorporated townships shall be assessed by the county commissioners, in like manner as is now provided by law for opening and making roads in said townships; and such assessment shall be made whenever they shall have satisfactory evidence that such roads need repairs.

Chapter 23.

An act to establish the salary of the county attorney for the county of Franklin.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Salary \$250 per
annum after
Jan. 1, 1866.

SECT. 1. The annual salary of the county attorney for the county of Franklin, shall be two hundred and fifty dollars, payable quarterly, from the first day of January last, which shall be in full for all official services.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
