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**Chapter 70.**

CHAP. 70.

Resolve abating state tax of the town of Harrington.

*Resolved*, That the treasurer of state be and he hereby is authorized and directed to abate two hundred sixty-six dollars twenty-four cents of the state tax assessed upon the town of Harrington in the county of Washington, for the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six, being the proportion of the state tax for eighteen hundred and sixty-six, chargeable upon the estates which were deducted from the valuation of the town of Harrington by a resolve approved February twenty-third, eighteen hundred sixty-six.

**Chapter 71.**

Resolve relating to the assumption by the general government of the war debts of loyal states, cities and towns.

WHEREAS, the expenditures made and debts incurred by the several states, cities and towns, of the loyal portion of the United States, in aid of the government during the war of the rebellion, were for the common benefit and should be borne by the whole country; therefore

Preamble.

*Resolved*, That these expenditures and debts ought to be assumed by the general government.

**Chapter 72.**

Resolve abating state tax of the town of Northport.

*Resolved*, That the treasurer of state be and he hereby is authorized and directed to abate one hundred and twenty dollars of the state tax assessed upon the town of Northport, in the county of Waldo, for the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six, being the proportion of the state tax for the year eighteen hundred and sixty-six, chargeable upon the estates which were deducted from the valuation of the town of Northport by a resolve passed February twenty-third, eighteen hundred and sixty-six.
