PRIVATE AND SPECIAL LAWS

OF THE

STATE OF MAINE.

Chapter 1.

An act to increase the capital stock of the Portland Kerosene Oil Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Portland Kerosene Oil Company is hereby authorized to increase the capital stock of said corporation, by adding thereto the sum of one hundred thousand dollars, so that the whole capital stock of said corporation shall amount to the sum of two hundred and fifty thousand dollars.

Increase of capital stock authorized.

SECT. 2. The said corporation may purchase and hold real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding two hundred and fifty thousand dollars, with full power to manage and dispose of the same.

May purchase and hold real and personal estate to amount of \$250,000.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 2.

An act to incorporate the Trustees of St. Catharine's Hall.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. Henry A. Neeley, Allen Lambard, James Bridge, Thomas Lambard, Eliphalet Nott, James M. Churchill, F. G. Richard, R. G. A. Freeman and J. Marshall Brown, their associates and successors, are hereby constituted a body politic and corporate by the name of the Trustees of St. Catharine's Hall, and
