#### WHARF IN BREWER .- SLUICE AT UPPER STILLWATER.

Said corporation is authorized to make such by-laws may agree. and regulations as it may deem necessary for the purposes of their Powers and incorporation, not inconsistent with the laws of this state. Either of the persons named in this act may call the first meeting of the corporators by serving each of the others with a notice thereof seven days before the time of meeting.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

### Chapter 72.

An act authorizing Daniel Sargent 2d to build piers and a wharf in tido waters of Penobscot river, in the town of Brewer.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. Daniel Sargent 2d, his heirs and assigns, are hereby The building of authorized to build and maintain two or more piers and a wharf into tide water from his shore into the tide waters of Penobscot river, in the town of Brewer, for the greater convenience of the shipment of lumber; provided he shall not extend said wharf or piers more than one Provise. hundred feet from low water mark.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

#### Chapter 73.

An act to authorize the erection and maintenance of a sluice at Upper Stillwater.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legis*lature assembled*, as follows:

Pickering, their associates, successors and assigns, are hereby constituted a body politic and corporate, by the name of the Orono Sluice Company, with power corporate name. to erect and maintain a sluice and sluiceway at Upper Stillwater, Power. so called, in the town of Oldtown, at such location, and upon such conditions as the county commissioners of Penobscot county shall direct, for the purpose of running logs and other unmanufactured lumber by or through the Upper Stillwater dam in said Oldtown,
