CHAP. 102

Rights and  
privileges.  
First meeting,  
how called.

SECT. 2. Either of the persons herein named as corporators, may call the first meeting for organizing the company, by giving five days' personal notice to the others.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.

### Chapter 102.

An act to change the name of certain persons.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECT. 1. Deborah L. Keef is hereby authorized to take the name of Deborah L. Newman; Rebecca Dawin is hereby authorized to take the name of Rebecca Snell.

Names changed.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

### Chapter 103.

An act amending the act establishing the amount of the capital stock of the Boston and Maine Railroad.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECT. 1. The act establishing the amount of the capital stock of the Boston and Maine Railroad, approved February eleventh, eighteen hundred and sixty-nine, is hereby amended by inserting after the words "the shares already issued being forty-five thousand," in the fourth line of section one, the words 'five hundred,' so that said portion of the sentence shall read: 'the shares already issued being forty-five thousand five hundred.'

Capital stock

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
