SECT. 4. Said corporation is authorized to purchase, lease, and Mayhold real and hold such real and personal property, as it may deem necessary, for proper transaction of its business, and to sell, lease and convey, and manage the same; said corporation may adopt a code of by- ny-laws. laws not inconsistent with the laws of the state.

SECT. 5. John Lynch and Frederick Robie, herein named, are First meeting, authorized to call the first meeting of said corporation, by serving three days' written notice on each of the other corporators.

SECT. 6. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 188.

An act to extend the time for the completion of the location of the branches of the European and North American Railway Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. The European and North American Railway Company may have a further time of two years, from and after the approval of this act by the governor, to locate their tracks to the several mills upon the Penobscot river, to which by the laws of the state it is now authorized to construct tracks or branches.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 189.

An act to authorize the town of Westport to purchase and maintain the Westport bridge.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. The town of Westport is hereby authorized to pur- May purchase chase, repair and maintain the Westport bridge leading from the bridge, if town shall so vote. western shore of said town across the Sheepscot river to Woolwich, if the said town of Westport shall so vote, at any legal meeting of its inhabitants, called for that purpose.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
