### Chapter 23.

Resolve in aid of building a bridge over Dead river in the county of Somerset.

*Resolved*, That the sum of one thousand dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated in aid of building a bridge over Dead river at Flagstaff, in the county of Somerset; *provided* said bridge shall be completed to the satisfaction of the land agent, before said sum shall be paid by the state. Bridge over Dead river.

Approved February 22, 1869.

### Chapter 24.

Resolve in favor of Levi B. Ricker.

*Resolved*, That the land agent be and he is hereby authorized and directed to convey to Levi B. Ricker, lot of land numbered twenty-three in township six, range five, in the county of Aroostook, on payment of three hundred dollars, or so much thereof as has not been paid by said Ricker. Levi B. Ricker, in favor of.

### Chapter 25.

Resolve authorizing the land agent to obtain proposals for the purchase of proprietor's lands in the plantations of Madawaska, Dionne and D'Aigle, for settlement.

*Resolved*, That the land agent be and hereby is authorized and directed to confer with the proprietors or owners of lands, suitable for settlement, in the plantations of Madawaska, Dionne and D'Aigle, and obtain proposals for conveying the same to the state, and to report the same in his next annual report. Lands in Madawaska.
