Chapter 42.

Resolve in favor of the joint standing committee on state reform school.

Resolved, That the state treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to pay to Marquis D. L. Lane the sum of forty-six dollars, it being for actual expenses incurred by the committee visiting the state reform school, on the twenty-eighth day of January last. Chapter 43.

Resolve in favor of Joseph Fields, Jones Bisbee and B. J. Hines.

Resolved, That there be paid out of any money in the treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to Joseph Fields the sum of ninety-three dollars, to Jones Bisbee the sum of fifty-two dollars, to B. J. Hines the sum of fifty-six dollars, as compensation in full for all claim against the state, under the provisions of an act concerning contagious diseases among cattle, approved March nineteenth, eighteen hundred sixty-two, for loss of cattle by contagious disease, in the year eighteen hundred sixty-seven. Appropriation for loss of cattle.

Chapter 44.

Resolve in favor of the joint standing committee on the state prison.

Resolved, That the state treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to pay George Goodwin the sum of one hundred and forty-five dollars and fifty cents, it being for expenses incurred by the committee visiting the state prison, the third day of February, eighteen hundred sixty-nine.
