The first meeting of said company may be called by First meeting, either of the persons named in this act, by giving written notice to his associates seven days at least before the time of meeting.

This act shall take effect when approved.

#### Chapter 346.

An act to regulate the gathering of oranberries in the town of Lubec.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. No person shall gather either highland or heath cran- Cranberries, the berries, on any land or lands within the town of Lubec, of which regulated. he or she is not the lawful owner, or in lawful possession, at any time before the first day of September of each year, under a penalty of ten dollars for each offence.

This penalty may be recovered in an action of debt, Penalties. by any person in any court competent to try the same; one-half to the use of the plaintiff, the other half to the county.

This act shall take effect when approved.

Approved February 26, 1870.

### Chapter 347.

An act to change the name of the Gardiner District Campmeeting Association.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The Gardiner District Campmeeting Association shall Name changed. hereafter be called and known as the Empire Grove Campmeeting Association.

This act shall take effect when approved.
