thereof to meet at some suitable time and place within the limits Chap. 581. aforesaid, the notice to be posted up in two public places within said limits seven days before the time of said meeting; and either of said persons are authorized to preside at said meeting until after its organization and until its officers shall be chosen and sworn; and afterwards at all meetings of the corporation a moderator shall be chosen in the same manner and with the same powers as in town meetings.

SECT. 9. At the first meeting of said corporation the legal Charter, acceptvoters shall vote by ballot on the question of accepting this charter, and if two-thirds of the voters present at said meeting shall vote in favor of its acceptance, then this act shall take effect and the corporation shall then proceed to organize and choose its officers.

SECT. 10. This act shall take effect when approved by the Act to take effect governor, so far as to empower the said first meeting to be called, and if this charter shall be accepted as provided in section nine of this act, then the same shall take and have complete effect in all its parts.

#### Chapter 581.

An act additional to "an act to incorporate the International Telegraph Company."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. The International Telegraph Company is hereby authorized to extend its lines beyond the limits of this state to the city of Washington, in the District of Columbia, by one route, or more, as the directors may determine; and for this purpose said company may construct, or may lease or purchase of any other company or companies, and may hold, maintain and operate such the state, and any such lease or purlines the same as if within this state, subject to the provisions of its charter. And any such lease or purchase already made is hereby authorized and made valid.

Extension of lines beyond limits of state, authorized.

Company may construct, or may lease or purchase of any other company or com-panies, lines in chase, already made, is hereby made valid.

Said company is hereby authorized to increase its Capital stock, capital stock to such amount as may be deemed necessary for the authorized. purposes named in this act.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
