Chapter 159.

CHAP. 159.

An act to authorize the jailor of York county to remove prisoners in certain cases.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. The jailor of the county of York is hereby authorized to remove any prisoners or debtors in custody in the jail of said county, or who may be committed thereto, to the jail of the county of Cumberland while a new jail for said county of York is in process of construction and when he cannot accommodate such prisoners or debtors ; and the keeper of the jail in said county of Cumberland is hereby authorized to receive and detain in his custody all such prisoners and debtors ; *provided however*, that the county of York shall be liable to the county of Cumberland for all reasonable expenses and damage which accrues from any and all such commitments.

Jailor of York county authorized to remove prisoners to Cumberland county jail.

Proviso.

Expenses, damages, &c., how paid.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 160.

An act to incorporate the town of Island Falls.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. Island Falls plantation, composed of number four, range four, west from the east line of the state, in Aroostook county, is hereby incorporated into a town by the name of Island Falls, and the inhabitants of said town are hereby invested with all the powers, privileges, immunities and liabilities of other towns.

Powers, privileges, &c.

SECT. 2. Any justice of the peace within the county of Aroostook, is hereby empowered to issue his warrant to some inhabitant of said town, directing him to notify the inhabitants thereof to meet at such time and place as he shall appoint, to choose such officers as other towns are empowered to choose.

Meeting for choice of officers, how called.

SECT. 3. The town hereby created shall take the effects belonging to Island Falls plantation, and shall also assume all the obligations thereof.

Town to take the effects and discharge the liabilities of the plantation.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
