Chapter 1.

Resolve in favor America Bartlett.

Resolved, That the land agent be and he hereby is authorized Lot of land to be to sell and convey to America Bartlett, in the town of Lyndon America Bartlett, and county of Aroostook, a lot of land numbered seventeen in that part of Lyndon formerly I township, without performing further settling duties.

Approved January 27, 1872.

Chapter 2.

Resolve in favor of James Withee.

Resolved, That the land agent be and he hereby is authorized Lot of land to be to convey to James Withee the lot of land numbered fifty-four, in that part of the town of Lyndon formerly I township, in the county of Aroostook, at the usual price paid for settling lands without the performance of other settling duties.

Approved January 27, 1872.

Chapter 3.

Resolve in favor of Hiram Morse.

Resolved, That the land agent be and he is hereby authorized Lot of land to be to convey to Hiram Morse the lot of land numbered nine, in that Hiram Morse.
