Chapter 499.

Снар. 499.

An act to increase the capital stock of the North Bank at Rockland.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. The president, directors and company of the North Capital stock, to Bank of Rockland, are hereby authorized to increase the capital stock of said bank by adding thereto the sum of fifty thousand dollars, to be paid into said bank in lawful money of the United States, on or before the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred seventy-six, and to be divided into shares of one hundred Shares. dollars each, and loans may be made by said bank, on said additional capital whenever a majority of directors together with the cashier shall have signed and certified under oath, and filed in the office of the secretary of state, a certificate that said additional capital has been actually paid in.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 500.

An act additional to the acts which constitute the charter of Colby University.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. The powers vested jointly in the president and board Joint powers of trustees, by the acts which constitute the charter of Colby University, are hereby vested in the board of trustees, of which the president shall not be a member ex officio; but the board may elect their own presiding officer, to hold office for such term as shall be prescribed in the by-laws.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 501.

An act for the preservation of pickerel in Lovejoy's pond, in Albion.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. If any person or persons, between the first day of Protection of December and the first day of the following June, shall take or joy's pond. destroy except by hook and line, any pickerel in Lovejoy's pond
