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CHAP. 73.**Chapter 73.**

Resolve in favor of Jeanne M. Strickland.

Jeanne M. Strickland, in favor of.

*Resolved*, That the land agent be authorized to locate and convey to Jeanne M. Strickland, a lot of land not exceeding two hundred acres, from any township in which lands are owned by the state, to be in full payment of her claim as assignee of the rights granted to Gowen Wilson by chapter one hundred and eighty-four of the resolves of eighteen hundred and forty-nine.

**Chapter 74.**

Resolve in favor of Portland Public Library.

Portland public library, in favor of.

*Resolved*, That the state librarian be authorized and instructed to furnish to the public library of Portland, such volumes of public documents, special laws, resolves and journals of house and senate, as said library does not now possess, and which can be spared from the state library without detriment to the public interests.

**Chapter 75.**

Resolve in favor of Albion W. Stratton.

Albion W. Stratton, in favor of.

*Resolved*, That the land agent be authorized to convey to Albion W. Stratton, lot number fourteen, in section thirteen, in township number thirteen, range three, west from the east line of the state, waiving settling duties.
