## CHAP. 297

## Chapter 297.

An act to prevent the taking of Land-Locked Salmon and Black Bass in Moose Pond in the towns of Harmony and Hartland in the county of Somerset.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Taking of certain fish in Moose pond prohibited.

SECT. 1. All persons are prohibited from taking or catching any land-locked salmon or black bass in Moose pond in the towns of Harmony and Hartland in the county of Somerset, for the term of three years from the passage of this act.

Penalty for violating act.

SECT. 2. Any person convicted of violating the provisions of this act, shall be fined ten dollars and costs of prosecution, on complaint and proof of said taking or catching, before any trial justice.

Approved March 18, 1880.

## Chapter 298.

An act to incorporate the Canton Bridge Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Corporators.

SECT. 1. Charles H. Gilbert, Dura Bradford, Otis Hayford, Hiram A. Ellis, William H. H. Washburn, Granville Child, Ronello A. Barrows, John N. Read, and Herbert F. Hayford, with their associates and successors are hereby constituted a body corporate by the name of the Canton Bridge Company, for the purpose of erecting and keeping in repair a bridge over the Androscoggin river, within the limits of said town of Canton, at such place as said corporation may deem most practicable and convenient ; and the said corporation shall have power to purchase and hold such real and personal estate as may be necessary to carry into effect said object ; to prosecute and defend suits at law ; to have and use a common seal ; to make by-laws for the management of their concerns not repugnant to the laws of this state ; and to have and enjoy all the powers and privileges incident to or usually granted to similar corporations.

Corporate name, purpose, powers and privileges.

Bridge to be erected across Androscoggin river.

SECT. 2. Said bridge shall be erected across the Androscoggin river within the limits aforesaid, shall be constructed of good materials, of a suitable height from the water, and not less than twenty-four feet wide, with suitable and sufficient
