Resolve in favor of Printing the Insurance Laws.

Resolved, That the insurance commissioner be authorized, free of cost to the state, to compile the insurance laws now in force in this state, and cause not more than fifteen hundred copies thereof to be printed, for the use of his department.

Chapter 182.

Resolve in favor of the Committee on Reform School.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated, the sum of thirty-eight dollars, to pay the expenses of the committee on Reform School, in visiting said institution, according to the order of the legislature.

Chapter 183.

Resolve in favor of an act of Congress granting Pensions to veterans of the Mexican and Aroostook Wars.

Pensions to vete-
rans, act of con-
gress commended

Resolved, That the legislature of Maine joins with the legislatures of other states, which have heretofore taken action upon the subject, in commending the proposed act of congress to grant pensions to the veterans of the Mexican and Aroostook wars, as a just and beneficial measure.
