### Chapter 212.

Resolve making an appropriation for the propagation of fish.

*Resolved*, That the sum of three thousand five hundred and seventy-five dollars be, and is hereby appropriated, to be expended under the direction of the commissioners of fisheries, for the propagation of fish.

### Chapter 213.

Resolve in relation to school exercises and examinations.

*Resolved*, That among the exercises of the public schools, shall be the reading of the constitution of the United States, and the constitution of the state of Maine, as often as once in each term, by every scholar who has attained the age of fourteen years, either singly or in connection with a class, and that each scholar shall pass an examination at the close of each term, in the presence of the visiting superintending school committee or supervisor on the first, eighth and the thirteenth articles of amendments of the constitution of the United States and on article first of the constitution of Maine. And it shall be the duty of the teachers and of the superintending school committee or supervisor, in each town, to see that the requirements of the above resolve are carried into effect.
