CHAP. 14.

Chapter 14.

An act to authorize the extension of certain wharves in Portland Harbor.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Atlantic and St.
Lawrence R. R.
Co. authorized to
build wharves.

SECT. 1. The Atlantic and St. Lawrence Railroad Company and its lessees, are hereby authorized to build and maintain in the waters of Portland Harbor, and in front of any lands now owned or leased by said parties or which may be hereafter purchased or leased, a wharf or wharves extending into said waters to a distance not exceeding two hundred feet beyond the harbor line eastward of Galt's wharf, *provided* that the consent of the harbor commissioners of Portland or the city council of Portland shall first be obtained.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 15.

An act to amend the charter of the Godfrey Falls Dam Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Act of 1872,
amended.

SECT. 1. An act entitled "An act to incorporate the Godfrey Falls Dam Company," approved February two, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two, and an act entitled "An act to amend the charter of the Godfrey Falls Dam Company," approved February two, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred* and seventy-two, are hereby amended as follows :

Corporation may

SECT. 2. The said corporation may build dams and make improvements on the ponds and lakes on Shin Pond stream, so called, for the purpose of raising a head of water to facilitate the driving of logs down said stream and the Seboois river.

Reduction of
tolls.

SECT. 3. When said corporation shall from tolls be reimbursed for all costs, expenses and incidental charges for erecting and maintaining all their dams and other improvements with twelve per centum interest, the tolls shall be
