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**Chapter 151.**

An act to incorporate the Maine Pedagogical Society.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECT. 1. A. W. Burr, H. L. Chapman, E. W. Hall, A. E. Chase, R. Woodbury, C. C. Rounds, M. C. Fernald and L. G. Jordan, their associates, successors and assigns, are hereby created a body politic and corporate by the name of the Maine Pedagogical Society, for the purpose of promoting the interests of education and work of instruction in this state, with all the rights and privileges, and subject to all the duties, liabilities and requirements of similar corporations, by the laws of this state

Corporators.

Corporate name, purpose, privileges and liabilities.

SECT. 2. Said corporation may purchase and hold real and personal property, to an amount not exceeding at any one time, ten thousand dollars, with full power to manage and dispose of the same.

Authorized to purchase and hold property.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Approved March 17, 1881.

**Chapter 152.**

An act to amend chapter eighty-five of the Special Laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "An act to provide schools for the training of teachers in Madawaska territory," as amended by chapter one hundred ninety of the Special Laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-nine.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECT. 1. Section two of chapter eighty-five of the special laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, as amended by chapter one hundred and ninety of the special laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-nine, is hereby amended to read as follows :

Sec. 2, ch. 85, special laws 1878, amended.

SECT. 2. To defray the expenses of said schools the sum of one thousand dollars is hereby appropriated in the manner hereinafter provided. The treasurer of the state shall annually deduct from any of the school moneys raised by the

Expenses of schools, how provided for.
