### 1881.

### Chapter 1.

Resolve in favor of Newell Joseph, Ropresentative of the Passamaquoddy Tribe of Indians.

Resolved, That there be paid from the state treasury one Nevell Joseph, hundred dollars to Newell Joseph for travel and attendance before the legislature as representative of the Passamaquoddy tribe of Indians.

Approved January 25, 1881.

#### Chapter 2.

Resolve in favor of Joseph Nicolar, Representative of the Ponobscot Tribe of Indiaus.

Resolved, That there be paid from the state treasury one Joseph Nicolar, hundred dollars to Joseph Nicolar for travel and attendance before the legislature as representative of the Penobscot tribe of Indians.

Approved January 25, 1881.

### Chapter 3.

Resolve in favor of the town of Mayfield.

Resolved, That three hundred dollars be appropriated to Town of May-field, in favor of. assist the town of Mayfield in building a road leading from
