Chapter 1.

Resolve in favor of Newell Joseph, Representative of the Passamaquoddy Tribe of Indians.

Resolved, That there be paid from the state treasury one hundred dollars to Newell Joseph for travel and attendance before the legislature as representative of the Passamaquoddy tribe of Indians.

Chapter 2.

Resolve in favor of Joseph Nicolar, Representative of the Penobscot Tribe of Indians.

Resolved, That there be paid from the state treasury one hundred dollars to Joseph Nicolar for travel and attendance before the legislature as representative of the Penobscot tribe of Indians.

Chapter 3.

Resolve in favor of the town of Mayfield.

Resolved, That three hundred dollars be appropriated to assist the town of Mayfield in building a road leading from

field, in favor of.
