**Chapter 41.****CHAP. 41.**

Resolve in favor of the State Reform School.

*Resolved*, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of twenty-nine thousand dollars for the use of the reform school, of which shall be paid the sum of sixteen thousand dollars in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-one, four thousand of the same being to pay outstanding bills, and twelve thousand to meet the current expenses; and the sum of thirteen thousand dollars shall be paid in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-two, one thousand of which being for painting the buildings and other repairs, and twelve thousand to meet the current expenses.

Reform school, in favor of.

Approved March 15, 1881.

**Chapter 42.**

Resolves authorizing a Temporary Loan.

*Resolved*, That to provide for the wants of the treasury, the treasurer of state be, and he hereby is authorized to procure, on the faith of the state, if he shall deem it necessary, during the current year, a temporary loan of three hundred thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be needed.

Temporary loan authorized.

*Resolved*, That the treasurer of state is hereby authorized to give notes in behalf of the state, reimbursable within twelve months from the date hereof, for such portions of the loan hereby authorized as may be found necessary.

Approved March 15, 1881.

**Chapter 43.**

Resolves authorizing a Temporary Loan.

*Resolved*, That to provide for the wants of the treasury, the treasurer of state be, and he hereby is authorized to procure on the faith of the state, if he shall deem it necessary, at any time during the year eighteen hundred and eighty-two, a temporary loan of three hundred thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be needed.
