Chapter 126.

An Act relating to taxes on personal property.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Specification one of section fourteen of chapter six of the Sec. 14, ch. 6, R. revised statutes, as amended by chapter twenty-eight of the public laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-one, is hereby amended so to be as follows:

'First. All personal property employed in trade, in the erection of buildings or vessels, or in the mechanic arts, shall be taxed in the town where so employed on the first day of arts, where to be April in each year; provided, the owner, his servant, sub- Proviso. contractor or agent, so employing them occupies any store, shop, mill, wharf, landing-place or ship-yard therein for the purpose of such employment.'

Chapter 127.

An Act to provide for an annual examination of the accounts of the Treasurer of State.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The governor and council shall annually appoint a com- Governor and mittee, consisting of not less than three citizens of the state, who shall carefully examine the accounts of the state treasurer as embodied in his annual report, and certify in writing the result of such examination; and said certificate shall be appended to his report. They shall also examine all canceled bonds and coupons and destroy the same by burning in the presence of the treasurer, giving him a certificate of such de-They shall make a sworn report of their doings as struction.
